## Reasons Why You May Need to Consult an Attorney

The following are common reasons why GiftWise may *NOT* be the right solution for you.

- Your estate is complex or above the estate and gift tax exemption threshold (federal or state).
- · You expect your wishes may be contested.
- · You don't have access to witnesses.
- You own real estate outside of your home state.
- You own a business or investment properties.
- You are physically incapable of signing the will.
- You are participating in medical treatments that increase the chances of your capacity being challenged.
- You have a disability, or you have a child, spouse or other beneficiary with a disability.
- · You have children from multiple marriages.
- You have a premarital agreement that substantially changes your assets' position.
- · You are in the process of a divorce.
- Your caregiver, doctor or attorney is a beneficiary in your will.
- You have questions about your plan that you are not sure how to answer.
